

Dual College Enrollment

Dual College Enrollment is available to academically talented students as a provision awarding them credit toward high school graduation for completing selected college courses. The district has established dual enrollment programs with Paris Junior College, Virtual Schools Network and UT Odessa Permian. Students may enroll in college courses taught on the high school or college campus by qualified instructors.

Special registration for dual enrollment courses is required at both home high school campus and or the college and university. Counselors will provide details about enrollment. In order to receive credit toward high school graduation for course work completed under any of the programs, a grade of seventy or higher must be achieved.

TSI – college placement test must be taken and passed in order to enroll in college classes. Students must contact Paris Junior college for information regarding this test. Exemptions from the TSI test and ACT score of 23 or above composite with at least 19 or reading and math or SAT score of 1070 composite with 500 or above on reading and math.

Courses offered through Paris Junior College are English III DC, English IV DC, US History DC, Biology DC, and College Algebra (online).

Technical Dual Credit

North Lamar offers the following Technical Dual Credit courses through Paris Junior College; Plumbing, Cosmetology, Electrical and Electromechanical Engineering. These courses can lead to an industry recognized license or certification. Enrollment is restricted to juniors and seniors. These courses are taught either at Paris Junior College or Paris Junior High Vocational Building. Students must provide their own transportation.

To receive certification through a Technical Dual Credit course a North Lamar student must enroll in one of the following high school courses:

Plumbing - enroll in Piping and Plumbing Technology at NLHS as a 1st year student and Advanced Piping and Plumbing Technology at NLHS as a 2nd year student. Plumbing meets Monday - Thursday, 1:00 – 4:00 at PJC Annex 4. On Friday the student will be at NLHS from 1:00 – 3:20.

Cosmetology - enroll in Cosmetology I at NLHS as a 1st year student and Cosmetology II at NLHS as a 2nd year student. Cosmetology meets Monday – Friday, either 8:00 – 11:00 or 1:00-4:00, at Paris Junior High Facility.

Electrical - enroll in Electrical Technology at NLHS as a 1st year student and Advanced Electrical Technology at NLHS as a 2nd year student. Electrical meets Monday – Thursday, 1:00 – 4:00 at PJC-WTC. On Friday the student will be at NLHS from 1:00 – 3:20.

Electromechanical Engineering - enroll in Electronics at NLHS as a 1st year student and Advanced Electronics at NLHS as a 2nd year student. Electromechanical Engineering meets Monday – Thursday, 1:00 – 4:00 at PJC-WTC. On Friday the student will be at NLHS from 1:00-3:20.

North Lamar will pay tuition and fees for these Technical Dual Credit courses. Students are required to pay for books and all other expenses required for the course. **If a North Lamar student drops a Technical Dual Credit course after the 12th day of instruction, the student will be required to reimburse North Lamar for the tuition and fees on a pro-rated basis.**
